A visit to the Afrikaans Catholic Church in Pella, where we will share in its fascinating history.

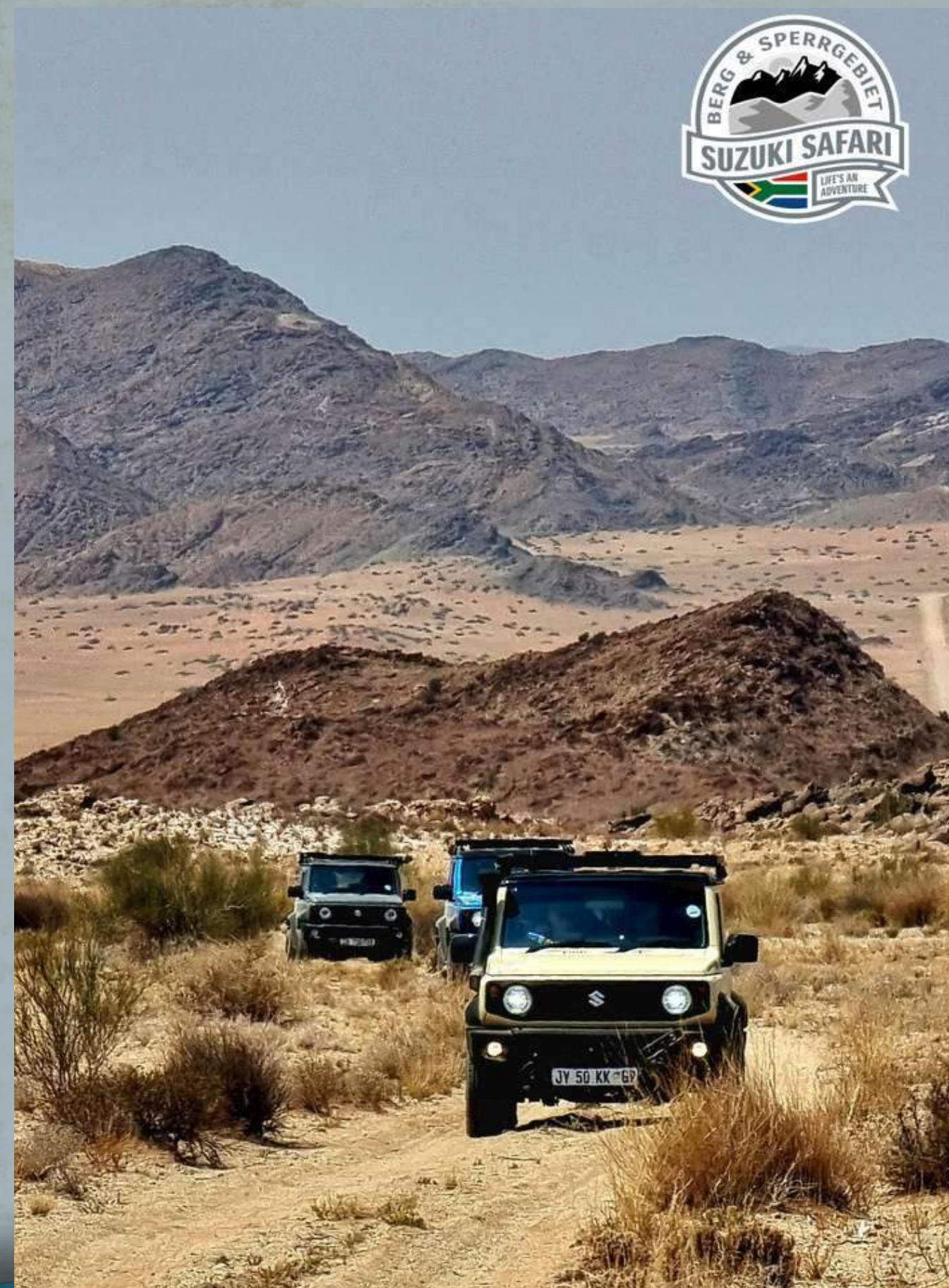
Driving along a track next to the Orange river through incredible views and vistas.
